



This act will establish approximately 208,160 acres of Federal land managed by the USFS and the BLM as the Rocky Mountain Front Conservation Management Area, and designate approximately 67,112 acres of land in the Lewis and Clark National Forest as additions to existing components of the National Wilderness Preservation System. All lands are within Lewis and Clark and Teton Counties, Montana
